The nominator must collect the following and submit all materials electronically to nelms@nelms.org by **February 1**.

- The **nominator** must address in writing how the **nominee** meets the criteria stated above in 1,250 words or less.

RECOGNITION:

Those who receive an award will be recognized at the NELMS Annual Conference and in MidLines, (the NELMS newspaper), receive a two-day registration to our Annual Conference, and be featured on the web site.

The recipient will also be invited to present the award to the next year's award winner at the Annual Conference Welcome & Recognitions Reception, along with a voucher for a two-day complimentary conference registration to attend the conference.
