**PURPOSE** – This program is intended to give public recognition to the two representative 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students in Maine who have distinguished themselves in terms of outstanding scholarship and leadership. *The selection of these two students will be the responsibility of each school. (See selection criteria on reverse)*

- Personal Goals
- Respect for diversity

**AWARDS BANQUET** – The 2 students selected, school representatives, and others, are invited to attend the statewide Scholar Leader Awards Banquet at the Augusta Civic Center in Augusta, Maine. The Governor, the Commissioner of Education and other dignitaries will be invited. Each student receives a plaque with his or her name on it signifying the honor. A photograph of the scholar leader receiving the award will also be given to each of the students.

**COST TO MEMBER SCHOOLS** – The cost of the event for the students being honored as scholar leaders will be paid by the Maine Association for Middle Level Education and the New England League of Middle Schools. For NELMS or MAMLE members tables of 8 are \$319.00 and tables of 10 are \$399.00. At times schools have asked local businesses or civic organizations, parent organizations, school activity funds, or the parents themselves to help fund their attendance at this event.

**COST TO NON-MEMBER SCHOOLS** – Schools that are not members of the Maine Association for Middle Level Education or the New England League of Middle Schools may also participate in this program, but must pay the expenses associated with the event.
