- One or two page summary of the unit explaining in 500 words or less how this unit meets the criteria using specific examples.
- *Please submit the Application, Written Statement, Unit Outline, Products at the same time*

Those who receive an award will be recognized at the NELMS Annual Conference, receive a two-day registration to our Annual Conference, and be featured in NELMS Publications.
