• The **nominator** must address in writing how the **nominee** meets the criteria stated above in 1,250 words or less.

Those who receive an award will be recognized at the NELMS Annual Conference and in *MidLines*, receive a two-day registration to our Annual Conference, and be featured on the web site.

The recipient will also be invited to present the award to next year's award winner at the Annual Conference Welcome & Recognitions Reception.
